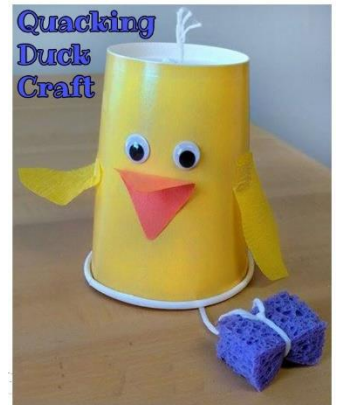


QUACKING DUCK

EDINBORO KIWANIS
HOLDS A DUCK RACE

SUPPLIES NEEDED

- Yellow plastic cup
- Orange paper to make beak
- String
- Push pin
- Sponge



HOW TO MAKE A QUACKING DUCK

1. Decorate plastic cup to look like a duck with the cup upside down.
2. Poke a hole in the bottom of the cup.
3. Thread a piece of string through the hole and dangle it out of the bottom of the cup.
4. Knot the top so the string will stay inside the cup. The string needs to hang 8-10 inches below the cup.
5. Wet a small piece of sponge and grab the string. To make the duck quack, jerk the sponge down the string.
